### ELECTION DAY NEWS PARKING AND TRAFFIC PLAN

Due to the high expected voter turnout on November 4<sup>th</sup> at the Longmeadow Community House, the town has setup an ELECTION PARKING AND TRAFFIC PLAN. This plan will be announced in the local newspapers and on the Longmeadow website. Maps will show where election parking will be located and highlight the one day traffic plan. Please be prepared for this high voter turnout by planning ahead. Read the ballot in advance, carpool, avoid peak voting times... early morning and mid afternoon and consider taking the Election Day Shuttle that will be running from Greenwood Center at 231 Maple Road to the Longmeadow Community House. Shuttle operating hours will be 6:45 AM starting at Greenwood and running every 20 minutes until 8:00 PM when the polls close. Pickup at Greenwood near the pool parking lot with drop off at the Community House on the Longmeadow Street Extension. ### 2008 Statewide Ballot Questions

**Question 4:** Shall the Town of Longmeadow be allowed to exempt from the provisions of proposition two-and-one-half, so-called, the amounts required to pay for the bonds issued in order to procure an owner's manager and to conduct a feasibility study to understand the extent of facility and programming deficiencies at the Longmeadow High School located at 95 Grassy Gutter Road, Longmeadow, MA 01106, located between Williams Street and Bliss Road and to explore the formulation of a solution for those deficiencies? *Yes or No*

### Do I Need To Change My Medicare Part D Plan?

Choices/changes for 2009 may be made from November 15, 2008 through December 31, 2008

- Review medications with your doctors;
- Save information you receive from your current health insurance plan regarding "creditable" coverage or changes in the formulary;
- If you are a MassHealth or Prescription Advantage member, be sure your plan premium is at or below \$31.74;
- Call your current insurance company to confirm premium changes, ask if your medications are still on the formulary and ask about the co-payment of each medication;
- To make an appointment with a local SHINE counselor to review all your insurance information. Call the Council on Aging at **565-4150**.
- Call Mass Medline at 1-866-633-1617 to discuss alternatives to brand name drugs, or other pharmacy benefits.

### Longmeadow 2008 Leaf Program

The Town of Longmeadow will be providing a curbside-bagged leaf collection program. Longmeadow residents will have three options for leaf disposal: 1) use the Town PAYT leaf collection program; 2) hire a private contractor for leaf removal; or 3) purchase a Recycling Center sticker and transport leaves directly to the meadows on West Road.

Town of Longmeadow leaf bags will be available for purchase at: Brightwood Hardware, Council on Aging, DPW offices on Pondsideroad during their regular hours of operation, and at the Recycling Center on Saturdays only. Cost of the bags is \$5 for 10 bags. The leaf drop-off site on West Road will open on October 27<sup>th</sup> and curbside collection of the special town leaf bags will begin on November 10<sup>th</sup> (depending on the weather). An annual Recycling Sticker is required for residents in order to use the West Road leaf drop-off site.
