Absentee Ballots are available in the Town Clerk's office. The deadline to apply for an Absentee Ballot is noon on September 15, 2008.

Absentee Ballots are available for a registered voter who will be unable to vote at the polls on election day due to:

1. absence from the town during normal polling hours; or
2. physical disability preventing you from going to the polling location; or
3. religious belief; **or**
4. a Massachusetts citizen absent from the state; Or
5. an active member of the armed forces or merchant marines, their spouse or dependent; or
6. a person confined in a correctional facility or a jail, except if by reason of felony conviction.

The State Primary will be held on September 16, 2008 at the Community House. The polls are open 7:00 am – 8:00 pm. Special Town meeting is October 28th at 7 pm at the Longmeadow High School.
