

Food Recall

**Recall of Fresh Tuna Steaks
Sold at Big Y, Shaws and Star Market
June 20-24, 2009**

Fresh Tuna Steaks sold between June 20-June 24 at Big Y Stores, Shaws, or Star Market were voluntarily recalled by the distributor due to elevated levels of histamine.

Ingestion of high levels of histamine results in symptoms of scombroid poisoning within minutes of ingestion. The most common symptoms of scombroid poisoning are tingling or burning in the mouth, a rash on the face and upper body, hives, itching or intestinal symptoms such as nausea, vomiting or diarrhea.

If you purchased tuna steak during that period from one of the listed retailers and have the frozen product in your freezer, you are urged to return the product to the retail store where it was purchased for a full refund.
