PAPER / CARDBOARD



- Paperback/Phone Books ~ covers OK
- Hardcover Books ~ remove covers
- Junk Mail
- Envelopes (window envelopes accepted)
- Newspapers/Inserts
- Magazines/Catalogs
- Brown Paper Bags
- White/Colored Paper ~ staples OK
- Computer/Office Paper/File Folders
- Shredded Paper
- Boxboard (cereal, shoe, cracker boxes, etc.)
 - ~ remove plastic, wax liners
- CLEAN Pizza Boxes
- Corrugated Cardboard
 - ~ flatten, remove tape, string
 - ~ no waxed cardboard

Note: All paper/cardboard should be clean/dry

CONTAINERS



- Glass Bottles/Jars (all colors/sizes)
 - ~ labels, lids, corks, neck rings, etc. may stay
- Aluminum, Tin/Steel Cans/Lids, Aluminum Foil
 - ~ labels may stay
- Plastic Bottles/Jars/Tubs
 - ~ remove pumps
 - ~ labels, detergent spouts, caps/lids may stay
- Milk/Juice Cartons (tent top), Drink Boxes
 - ~ flatten

Note: No plastic bags. Rinse containers.
Recycle plastic grocery bags at local stores.

DO NOT RECYCLE

- Broken Glass/Batteries
- Ceramics/Pottery
- Coat Hangers
- Contaminated Paper
- Detergent Boxes
- Dishes/Pots and Pans
- Drinking/Eye Glasses
