

**MINUTES OF A PUBLIC HEARING
LONGMEADOW BOARD OF HEALTH**

RE: PROPOSED REGULATION BANNING OUTDOOR WOOD BOILERS

Monday, January 5, 2007 7:30P.M. Longmeadow Fire Dept. Community Rm.

The Public Hearing was called to order by the Chair at 7:35 P.M. with the following Board of Health members in attendance: Dr. Robert Rappaport, Dr. Barry Izenstein, Dr. Richard Steingart, and Dr. Michael Coppola. MaryPat Toye was excused (out of the country). . Also present were Longmeadow residents Cut freedman and Eleanor Stolar and Chicopee resident, Joseph Tumidajewicz.

Mr. Freedman, the only speaker from the public, spoke in favor of the proposed regulation. He also provided written testimony. In addition, Mr. Freedman requested that indoor wood furnaces be addressed by the regulation. Inasmuch as the required public notice had only been given in regard to regulation of outdoor wood burners, the board could not honor this request at this time. The regulation of indoor wood furnaces was tabled for future action.

The hearing was adjourned at 7:50 P.M.
