

**MINUTES OF EMERGENCY MEETING
LONGMEADOW BOARD OF HEALTH
Monday, December 12, 2005 7:30 P.M. Longmeadow Fire Station**

The Emergency Meeting of the Longmeadow Board of Health was convened at 7:30 P.M. by Dr. Robert Rappaport, Chair, with the following members in attendance: Michael Coppola, M.D., MaryPat Toye, R.N. M.S., and Barry Izenstein, M.D.. Also in attendance was Beverly Hirschhorn, Health Director.

This meeting was posted at the Town Hall by the Town Clerk this afternoon as an Emergency Meeting. This posting does not conform to the normal public notice required under the Open Meeting Law but does meet the public notice waiver requirement for emergency meetings provided by the Law in respect to documentation of an immediate threat to life and safety of a person(s).

The meeting was called to respond to critical violations of the Sanitary Code Article II of a residence in Longmeadow. This home is occupied by two elders, one of who has serious medical problems and whose health is being seriously imperiled by the conditions of the residence.

Dr. Rappaport made a motion to go into Executive Session in order to discuss personal medical information of the home's residents documented in a December 12, 2005 Police/EMS Report and litigation strategy in respect to enforcement of the Article II Sanitary Code violations of the dwelling where these residents reside that pose an immediate threat to their health and safety. The results of the roll call vote of the Board to go into Executive Session were: Voting for the motion –Dr. Rappaport, Dr. Coppola, Marypat Toye, and Dr. Izenstein; Voting against the motion-none.

Prior to adjourning into Executive Session at 7:40P.M. Dr. Rappaport stated for the record that the Emergency Meeting would not reconvene that evening after the Executive Session is concluded.

The next meeting of the Board would probably be scheduled in January to review outstanding non-emergency issues. Members will be polled next week regarding their availability to attend a meeting in January.
