

MINUTES OF THE DECEMBER 13, 2006 MEETING

A meeting of the Longmeadow Conservation Commission was called to order at 7:33 PM on December 13, 2006, in the Community Meeting Room located at the Longmeadow Police Station, Williams Street.

MEMBERS PRESENT: John Bresnahan, Scott Foster, James Simon, Sheri Knight, Karen, Chadwell and Stephen Gazillo; **Absent:** Albert Laakso, Michael Houff.

OTHERS PRESENT: Lou Kornet, Jonathan Moss

MINUTES OF PRIOR MEETING: The minutes of November 8, 2006, were accepted.

TREASURER'S REPORT: There was no report as the Treasurer was absent.

Chairman John Bresnahan announced that there were no public hearings scheduled. Meeting proceeded.

John Bresnahan announced that he had spoken with Landscaper, Steve Roberts in regard to the following items and notified him that

1. There was no need to extend the date on the Order of Conditions for DEP #205-274, 290 Shaker Road, as it was still within a 3-year time frame.
2. The request for additional work at 101 Woodsley Rd (DEP #205-271) such as changing the existing fence and putting up a deer fence did not require a new permit.
3. In regard to 33 Mill Rd, Steve will be working on restoring and stabilizing the stream bank and wanted some input before filing an RDA. John informed Steve that the federal government looked at the property on a site visit and that there may be federal funds available for this project.

Next on the agenda were Jonathan Moss and Lou Kornet who presented to the CC a Rowing Program for the Riverfront on Conservation land. This would be for recreational boating and rowing. The gentlemen expressed their hope that the high school and Park and Rec. would eventually have a rowing program.

The area of interest is a lot South of the Pioneer Valley Yacht Club (PVYC). A portable dock and storage box would be needed; the storage box would be put on cinder blocks and an engineer would have to be hired to work on this part of the project.

Jonathan Moss submitted a proposal outlining Rowing History, program needs, short-term goals and long-term goals and a diagram of the area. John Bresnahan will check with the Select Board for any restrictions and will be in contact with Jonathan Moss and Lou Kornet. The Conservation Commission seemed interested in this project.

The meeting adjourned at 8:30 PM.
