

## **MINUTES OF THE MARCH 14, 2007 MEETING**

A meeting of the Longmeadow Conservation Commission was called to order at 7:00 PM on March 14, 2007, in the conference room at the Longmeadow Police Station.

**MEMBERS PRESENT:** John Bresnahan, Albert Laakso, Jim Simon and Stephen Gazillo; Absent: Scott Foster, Karen Chadwell and Sheri Knight.

**OTHERS PRESENT:** see attached

**MINUTES OF PRIOR MEETING:** The minutes of February 28, 2007, were accepted.

**TREASURER'S REPORT:** Salary account, \$1803.16; Maintenance account, \$850; Misc. account, \$390.65. The Treasurer's report was accepted.

**OTHER BUSINESS: Japanese Knotweed, Fannie Stebbins Wildlife Refuge** – John Bresnahan forwarded signed papers to Chris Polatin, licensed ecologist, approving his working on the project, when the project is approved.

A request that a Certificate of Compliance be issued by resident at 580 Frank Smith Road was received. Jim Simon will make a site visit.

John Bresnahan announced that the Committee for the Community Preservation Act was looking for volunteers from the various Town boards. Stephen Gazillo volunteered to be on the committee.

**NOI 205-278** – Mill Road continuance – Pete Levesque presented the CC with a Supplemental Plan. The water and sewer lines are to be rerouted and hung from the bridge; stream disturbance will be eliminated and there will be less impact on the wetland area. Mr. Cambi will subdivide the land (Cambi, 3.2 acres, 4.9 acres for estate lot, 11.65 acres donated to the Town). All will be deed restricted. Atty Karen Jackson stated per Town Council, Joel Bard, that Mr. Cambi has access to Mill Road, which allows access and the re-grading of the road. Pete Levesque requested that the CC vote on the project. A five-minute recess was taken at this time. When the meeting resumed, the CC did not vote on the NOI as the Commission wanted to have time to look over the supplemental information that was presented. The CC asked for a continuance until the next meeting, March 28<sup>th</sup>. The applicant did not agree. A motion was made to close the public hearing for NOI 205-278. Motion passed. The CC has 21 days to issue a decision.

The meeting adjourned at 9 PM.
