

## **MINUTES OF THE SEPTEMBER 9, 2009 MEETING**

A meeting of the Longmeadow Conservation Commission was called to order at 7:02 PM on September 9, 2009, in the Conference Room located at the Longmeadow Police Station.

**MEMBERS PRESENT:** Albert Laakso, Stephen Gazillo, James Simon, Karen Chadwell and Peter Bouvier. Absent: James Wheeler and John Bresnahan.

**OTHERS PRESENT:** Chris & Matt Regan, Michael Mocko, Bob Barkett

**MINUTES OF PRIOR MEETING:** The minutes of August 26, 2009 were accepted as amended.

**TREASURER'S REPORT:** Salary account, \$5921; Maintenance \$700; Misc. \$451; Wetland filing fees - \$7291.65; Trust Fund - \$10, 686.91.

**BOB BARKETT – SELECT BOARD** – Bob Barkett was present for an informational meeting with the CC. Residents were asking about the possibility of the Twin Hills Country Club property becoming available to the town. The town has first right of refusal but has not had any information as yet.

The School Committee held a public forum regarding the High School and focus was on Wolf Swamp Road property. There will be another forum on September 16<sup>th</sup> at Glenbrook Middle School.

The CC thanked Mr. Barkett for the update.

**NOI 205-289 - 74 DUNN ROAD:** The CC made a site inspection on Friday, September 4<sup>th</sup>. Michael Mocko presented a revised plan and addendum to the NOI. Compensatory Storage was proposed by means of removal of a mound of brick and old wood debris. These areas would be restored by two additional shad bushes and shrubs and plantings. There will also be a clean-up of adjoining CC land.

Motion was made to accept the NOI and issue an OOC with special conditions:

1. 5 days notice given to the CC before work starts.
2. Compensatory storage per the addendum dated September 9, 2009 be provided.
3. That two growing seasons occur before a Certificate of Compliance is issued.

Motion passed. The hearing was closed.

**OTHER BUSINESS:** On September 8, 2009 Al Laakso and Peter Bouvier of the CC met with Michael Wrabel of the DPW to discuss the Leaf Collection Program. The issues were on traffic control, signage, leaf drop off area and site management. The leaf program will continue in the fall.

Peter Bouvier made a site visit to the Pioneer Valley Yacht Club where it was reported that a tree limb had fallen on a boat docked near CC land. The Yacht Club will report this incident to its insurance company.
