

CURBSIDE REGULATIONS

TRASH COLLECTION

- Trash is collected weekly and must be placed at curbside by 7:00 AM on your scheduled collection day.
- One 36 gallon barrel or bag of trash is allowed per household per week. A maximum of 40 pounds is allowed per household.
- Trash in excess of the first 36-gallon bag or barrel may only be disposed of in Town approved trash bags available at local retail stores for \$1.75 per bag (in rolls of five).
- Excess trash not in Town approved bags will not be picked up.
- A limit of two rimless tires/week/household will be collected at curbside.
- Hazardous materials may not be included with your trash.
- The following items may not be included with curbside trash. They may be accepted at the Town's Recycling and Yard Waste Center. Fees may apply.
 - Leaves and yard waste
 - CRTs (TVs, computer monitors)
 - Demolition/construction materials

RECYCLING REGULATIONS

- Recyclables are collected at curbside on the same day as your trash with paper and containers collected on alternating weeks.
- Recyclables must be placed curbside with your trash by 7:00 AM.
- Recyclable material must be placed in Recycling Bins, available at the Town DPW office, or in clearly marked barrels.
- There is no limit on the amount of recyclables that will be collected.
- The Town recycles the following curbside: glass containers, metal cans, 1-7 plastics, paper, cardboard and newspaper. (see "What Can go in the Recycling Bins" at www.longmeadow.org)

IMPORTANT REMINDERS

Town trash collection will be delayed one day following Christmas, New Years Day, Thanksgiving, Memorial Day, the Fourth of July and Labor Day.

Trash that does not conform to regulations will be tagged and left at the curbside.
