MINUTES APRIL 12, 2011

After notice duly given, the Cable Advisory Committee met in open session on April 12, 2011 in the Police Department Community Room located at the Public Safety Complex on Williams Street. New Business: There is an agreement in principle with Comcast regarding a franchise renewal. The legal wording is being worked out between Peter Epstein and Mr. Fitzgibbons. Comcast has filed its Form 100. LCTV is using the Town's fiber I-Net and has abandoned the Comcast I-Net. Comcast has not as yet decided when to change the Basic Service from analog to digital. There is nothing happening with the Verizon bill in the State House.
