

Meeting Minutes Longmeadow
Historic District Commission
Tuesday, March 8, 2022

The Longmeadow Historic District Commission met on March 8, 2022 at 7:00pm via Zoom.

Public Comments:

Old Business:

1. Minutes from the February 8, 2022 meeting were unanimously approved.
2. Columbia Gas Update: Tim has only heard from one of the concern recipients, Karen Wagner who said she would turn in her application soon. Other than her, we have not received any applications. The deadline for turning in the applications is April 10, 2022. Tim will consult with Town Counsel, the Town Manager and the Select Board concerning applications that are not turned in ahead of that deadline.
3. Eversource Gas Pipeline: No update.
4. Certified Local Government Application: Tim asked those who had not turned in their resume yet to do so by March 15, 2022.
5. Plan for Historic Preservation: No update
6. Longmeadow Historic District Commission 2021 Historic Preservation Award
 - a. The HDC decided to award a 2020 award retroactively to 942 Longmeadow Street as well as award the 2021 award to 931 Longmeadow Street. For this year, the awards will be presented at town meeting and in the future we will potentially plan a standalone award ceremony.

New Business:

1. 021622 - Ben and Anna Kraus. 857 Longmeadow Street - Alter the detached garage on the northeast corner of the property as follows; on the north facing

side; remove garage door, add wood siding painted white, add two Anderson Colonial Series windows, a wooden door in the style of the one on the main house, and add a portico over the door. On the westward facing side, install two colonial series windows. On the eastward facing side, install two colonial series windows. The application was approved unanimously.

2. Application 102521 which was to replace the fence behind the Storrs' house was approved by the CPC and the measure to fund the fence removal and replacement will be on the warrant at the annual town meeting.
