

Meeting Minutes Longmeadow  
Historic District Commission  
Tuesday, March 10, 2020

The Longmeadow Historic District Commission met on Tuesday, March 10 at 7:00pm at the Fire Station Meeting Room.

Present from the HDC were: Tim Casey,, Clifford Scott, Bret Lukezic, Jonathan Jordan, Diane Fisher, and Paul Calento. Absent were Rob Mulcahy, Carri Greenman, Melissa McDonough and Ryan Shanks. Also present were Stephen Jablonski, John Stankiewicz, Alan Harwood, and Molly Harwood.

The meeting was called to order at 7:03 pm.

Public Comments: There were no public comments

Old Business:

1. Minutes from the December 10, 2019 meeting were unanimously approved.
2. Clifford Scott stated that Eversource, the successor to Columbia Gas, had come by his house looking to move his gas meter. Clifford said he would pass on the contact information for the team that approached him to Tim so he can contact them about the work they plan on doing.
3. The new enforcement section of the rules and regulations with the updates made by town counsel was approved unanimously.

New Business:

1. Application 020520-Bay Path University for 577 Longmeadow Street to Demolish shed, add a handicap access ramp, vestibule to the south side of the house, to remove and then put a new path on the south side of the house, two new parking spots behind the building, and paved connection with Greenacre including curb cut. Presented by architect Stephen Jablonski and new head of public safety for Bay Path John Stankiewicz. Alan and Molly Harwood abutters to the property spoke in favor of the project. The application was approved unanimously.
2. Carri Greenman was not present at the meeting but will provide an update at the next meeting on the optional addendum to listings for realtors. Paul Calento said he has learned the process for uploading the information into Google maps and will have it done for our next meeting.
3. Tim stated that he is exploring the possibility of digital meetings if the Covid19 outbreak causes the cancellation of in-person public meetings. He believes it may be possible to use existing town resources that the town uses for online forums to conduct HDC meetings digitally if the need were to arise.
