Historic District Commission

The Longmeadow Historic District Commission met on Tuesday, May 12 at 7:00pm via a Zoom video conference call.

Public Comments: Betsy McKee inquired about the status of stockade fences in the historic district. Tim Casey stated that any stockade fences currently in the district were put in before the HDC design guidelines forbade them. While current stockade fences are permitted to stay, no new stockade fences are allowed.

Old Business:

1. Minutes from the April 14, 2020 meeting were unanimously approved.
2. Columbia Gas update: Tim has not heard anything and will be reaching out to Mario Mazza for assistance with getting in contact with someone from Eversource
3. Nick Georgantas has informed Tim that the Town has decided to put the EV charging station behind the library and in a place that is not visible from a public way. The HDC will not be receiving another application because it is outside our jurisdiction

1. Application 040920-Louis and Ruth Robin for 942 Longmeadow Street to change the paint color of their house from white to gray-blue. The application was approved unanimously with an addendum to include the removal of a fence on the south east side of the property.
2. Carri Greenman was not at the meeting and will provide an update on the listing addendum next meeting.
3. Paul Calento was not at the meeting and will provide an update on the status of the Google maps project next meeting
