



Park Rules & Usage

Parks are open from Dawn to Dusk. Individuals may use athletic fields when not otherwise in use for permitted events, such as organized leagues or practice.

Athletic fields within Public Parks are available for use by groups if a permit is obtained from the Parks and Recreation Department

The Following Activities are Prohibited:

- Use of alcoholic beverages and any other chemical stimulants
- Use of smoking materials
- Games of chance, betting or gambling
- Defacing any facility or destruction of any growing plant or tree
- Dressing or undressing except in designated dressing rooms
- Hunting or disturbing animal habitat
- Commercial activity of any kind, except by permit issued by the Park and Recreation Department
- Amplified music that disturbs others
- Use of public Parks for dumping garbage, waste or other trash
- Use of abusive and profane language or any other activity constituting a breach of peace.
- Use of firearms, ammunition and fireworks
- Swimming (except in pools during hours of operation) or boating
- Ice skating
- Golf practice
- Paintball or use of paintball guns
- Any games or other conduct which is injurious or potentially injurious to others.
- Motorized vehicles and scooters
- Fires for cooking except on grills
- Gatherings of 75 or more people require a permit from the Parks and Recreation Dept.
- Horses in public parks
- Use of tennis courts for roller skates, roller blades, skateboards, bikes and any other activity except tennis is prohibited.
- Please Keep Our Parks Looking Beautiful. Pick up and Dispose of all Trash.

Dogs in Public Parks are subject to all Town of Longmeadow General Bylaws including, but not limited to, the following provisions:

- Prohibition of dogs on school grounds and within 100 feet of a pool (Section 5-306).
- Prohibition of dogs on athletic fields (Sections 5-320 and 5-320A).
- Removal of dog waste (Section 5-322).
