Town of Longmeadow Update COVID-19 Coronavirus

Town Payment Due Dates

April 24, 2020

Today, the Select Board, acting under newly granted authority by the Legislature and Governor, adopted measures related to the extension of due dates for property taxes, betterments and Community Preservation surcharges, exemption and deferral applications, and motor vehicle excise, water, sewer and stormwater utility bills:

Fourth Quarter Real Estate, Betterments and Community Preservation surcharges:

- Original Due Date: May 1, 2020
- New Due Date: June 1, 2020

Property Tax Personal Exemption and Tax Deferral Applications:

- Original Due Date: April 1, 2020
- Extended Due Date: June 1, 2020

Waiving the payment of interest and late payments for Motor Vehicle Excise Taxes:

- Any bills originally due May 6, 2020, now can be paid on or before June 29, 2020 without incurring additional costs.

Water, Sewer and Stormwater Utility Bills:

- Any bills originally due April 6, 2020, now can be paid on or before June 29, 2020 without incurring additional costs.

During the COVID-19 emergency, the office of the Treasurer/Collector is closed to the public. However, there are several optional payment methods available:
